

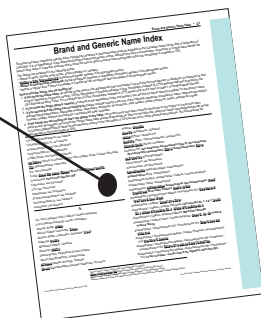

This section is an alphabetical, cross-referenced index of brand and generic names of products available in Canada including CPhA monographs.

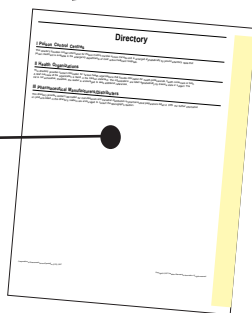

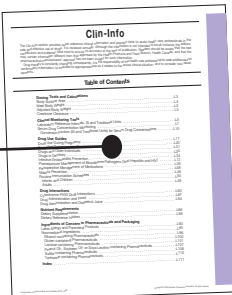

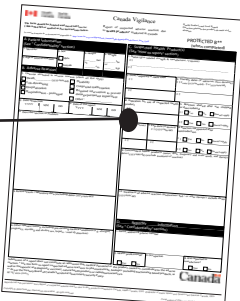

Valuable clinical information and practice tools to assist health care professionals use drugs safely and effectively.



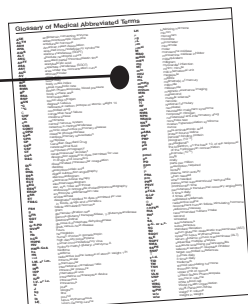

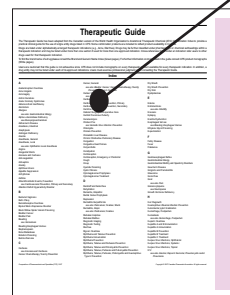
Product Identification

Product Monographs:

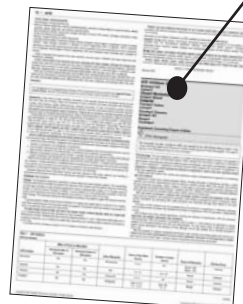
