ACTIVITY 1: WILDERNESS EXPLORER HUMMER TOUR

Travel into the backcountry of the Soo Valley, Cougar and Rainbow Mountains. This tour features a vast network of off-road trails, aboard our unique, customized vehicles that run on 100% vegetable oil. Our guides will take guests to amazing viewpoints, pristine alpine lakes and rugged backcountry - keep your eyes peeled for wildlife! A must-do while in Whistler, great for families!

ACTIVITY 2: GREEN RIVER RAFTING

ACTIVITY 3: SQUAMISH LIL'WAT CULTURAL CENTRE TOUR WITH DRUM-MAKING WORKSHOP

Get an in-depth look at the history and culture of Whistler's two First Nations. The tour starts off with a Cultural Presentation followed by a 15-minute film, a spectacular visual portrayal of Squamish and Lil'wat traditional territories featuring their languages, history and present day lives. Afterward, view exhibits that explore the First Nations relationship to the land and objects that celebrate traditions of art, music and ceremony, past and present. End with a drum-making workshop. Drums are one of the most important symbols and pieces within both the Squamish and Lil'wat Nations. If this is your first drum making class, come prepared with a name of the person who will be honoured with your drum, as it is traditional to give your first one away.

ACTIVITY 4: ZIPTREK TOUR
