Methodology

Online Survey	Survey was conducted online with a representative sample of Canadians from Research Now's online panel.
Sample Size	2,937 (Comparable Margin of Error <u>+</u> 1.8%)
Field dates	February 14 to 22, 2015
Statistical Weighting	Data was weighted by age, gender, education and region. In Quebec, results were also weighted by official language.

Executive Summary

Abacus Data's survey of 2,937 Canadians finds that pharmacists are viewed positively by almost all Canadians and a large majority consider pharmacists to not only play a trusted, central role in the health care system, but would like to see that role expanded.

While Canadians overall trust the advice provided by pharmacists, trust was stronger among those who visited pharmacies more frequently and among those over 60. This high level of trust was underpinned by a strong feeling among Canadians that pharmacists have the education and professional training to do more for patients, expanding their practice into related areas of the health care system.


The expanded scope of practice Canadians would be willing to accept ranged from advice, counselling and planning, to more direct forms of treatment, including the administration of vaccines and prescribing medications for minor health conditions.

Key findings:

- Overall, a majority of respondents expressed a great deal or complete trust in pharmacists to carry out a range of roles, including providing advice on medications (78%), management of common ailments like the cold or flu (67%), vaccinations (59%), healthy lifestyle changes (57%), and the management of chronic conditions (51%)
- There was a direct relationship between frequency of visits across all of the above tested statements, with those who visit pharmacies more frequently having a higher degree of trust.
- 85% of respondents felt that pharmacists have the education and professional training to do more for patients than fill prescriptions
- A majority of Canadians would consider going to their pharmacists for an increased range of services, including advice on medications (89%), a flu shot or vaccine (79%), prescriptions for minor health conditions (78%), and counselling programs to help quit smoking (75%).
- Over half (51%) of respondents reported going to a pharmacy at least once a month over the past year, with 89% returning to the same pharmacy. 36% reported knowing their pharmacist by name




Trusted Advice - Pharmacist






Advice from Pharmacist - Medicines






Advice from Pharmacist- Vaccinations






Advice from Pharmacist – Chronic Health Conditions






Advice from Pharmacists – Healthy Lifestyle Changes














Would you consider or not consider going to your pharmacist to receive the following services if you needed them?






Would you consider or not consider going to your pharmacist to receive the following services if you needed them? - Flu shot or other vaccines






Would you consider or not consider going to your pharmacist to receive the following services if you needed them? - **Advice on medications**






Would you consider or not consider going to your pharmacist to receive the following services if you needed them? - An appointment with your pharmacist to sit down to review and discuss your medications






Would you consider or not consider going to your pharmacist to receive the following services if you needed them? - Counselling programs to help quit smoking






Would you consider or not consider going to your pharmacist to receive the following services if you needed them? - **Prescribing medications for some minor health conditions without a doctor**






Would you consider or not consider going to your pharmacist to receive the following services if you needed them? - **Screening for medical conditions such as diabetes**


Approximately how often have you visited a pharmacy in the last 12 months?






Different Pharmacies


