# 10 simple ways to get involved

# **Key messages**

What is PAM? Pharmacy Appreciation Month (previously "Pharmacy Awareness Month") is the annual national campaign that shines a spotlight on all things pharmacy. Celebrated each March, PAM is a time to highlight the growing role pharmacy professionals play in our health-care system and thank them for their extraordinary efforts.

The role of pharmacy professionals is growing to meet our health-care needs: Over the past year we've seen new authorities and new funding for pharmacy services, illustrating that governments are aligning health-care delivery models with patient needs and expectations. From coast to coast to coast, we've witnessed pharmacists further empowered to practice towards their full scope, and to serve their patients with fewer barriers.

**Pharmacy teams are improving access for patients and reducing strain on our health-care system:** With a health-care system under significant strain, pharmacy teams are more essential than ever before. Pharmacy professionals have grown their roles as immunizers, as prescribers, and as the first point of contact to the health-care system for patients across the country.

Funding for pharmacy care and empowering pharmacy professionals improves access to health-care services in our communities: As provinces and territories recognize the tremendous value that pharmacy teams can bring to their patients and to the health-care system, governments are authorizing new services and increasing funding for pharmacist services in many parts of Canada. As a result, we are seeing a growing awareness and enthusiasm from patients to access care at their pharmacies. In fact, 94% of Canadians agree that governments need to expand and fund community-based care, like health services available through pharmacies. Funding for pharmacy services is key for a healthy pharmacy workforce and a stronger health-care system.

Since the pandemic, Canadians' relationships with their pharmacy teams have grown: Over the past few years Canadians have turned to their pharmacies for health-care services and advice. In the process, they have discovered the power of pharmacy and forged new relationships with their pharmacy teams.

Pharmacy teams have been an immense force supporting Canadians and our health-care system through the many challenges we've faced: The contributions of Canada's pharmacy teams over the past few years have been remarkable. From supporting their communities through the pandemic, helping patients navigate care amidst the current health-care crisis, managing ongoing drug shortages and everything in between, pharmacy professionals have proven their value time and time again.

### **Quick facts:**

- Most Canadians live within 5km of a pharmacy.
- There are more than 46,000 pharmacists and 10,500 pharmacy technicians in Canada, working in over 11,500 pharmacies across the country.
- Pharmacists are consistently ranked as one of the most trusted professions in Canada and Canadians see their pharmacist more often than any other health-care professional.
- Canada's pharmacy teams have administered more than 25 million COVID-19 vaccines to-date.
- Every week pharmacists see about 10 million patients across the country.


